Comparison to quote: # 1

Summary: of the scene pg. 82- Determined to marry Juliet, Romeo hurries to Friar Lawrence. The Friar agrees to marry them, expressing the hope that the marriage may end the feud between the families.

Characters: Friar Lawrence and Romeo

Setting: Outside Friar Lawrence's cell

Quote #1: Quote from 2.3 with the literary device, antithesis.

Friar Lawrence sees a world of oppositions. He will play a vital (but unfortunately), he will play a part in what happens to Romeo and Juliet. Read lines 1-30 to yourself, and quietly emphasize each 'opposition' (antithesis).

Quote #2: Quote that reflects the character Friar Lawrence

Here Friar Lawrence is asking if Romeo has so quickly forgotten about Rosaline. This is the first scene where we are introduced to Friar Lawrence; however, we can already tell that he is close to Romeo since he has confided in him in the past concerning his relationships.

"Is Rosaline, whom thou didst love so dear,

Not truly in their hearts, but in their eyes" (II.iii. 70-3).
